This form must be used by one person only (or partnership). Writing must be in INK or INDELIBLE PENCIL. Use one line only for each dog. The name of the dog and all the details as recorded with The Kennel Club must be given on this entry form. If an error is made the dog may be disqualified by the Committee of the Kennel Club. All dogs must be REGISTERED at the Kennel Club in the name of the exhibitor. If the registration or transfer of ownership has not been confirmed it must be applied for before the closing date of entries. In case of dispute proof of postage of such applications may be required by the Kennel Club. Puppies under 6 months of age on the first day of the Show cannot be entered for competition. On no account will entries be accepted without fees. If a dog is in the process of Registration or Transfer at the time entry is made, add the letters NAF or TAF as appropriate after its name. Please put classes in numerical order and USE BLOCK CAPITALS throughout when completing this entry form. ***The Kennel Club Authority to Compete number (for dogs registered and resident outside the UK) must be stated or the entry will be returned.** PLEASE CHECK ALL DETAILS BEFORE POSTING.

DECLARATION I/We agree to submit to and be bound by Kennel Club Limited Rules and Regulations in their present form or as they may be amended from time to time in relation to all canine matters with which the Kennel Club is concerned and that this entry is made upon the basis that all current single or joint registered owners of this dog(s) have authorised/consented to this entry. I/We also undertake to abide by the Regulations of this Show and not to bring to the Show any dog which has contracted or been knowingly exposed to any infectious or contagious disease during the 21 days prior to the Show, or which is suffering from a visible condition which adversely affects its health or welfare, or to bring any dog which has been prepared for exhibition contrary to Kennel Club Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition F (Annex B). I/we agree without reservation that any Veterinary Surgeon operating on any of my/our dogs in such a way that the operation alters the natural conformation of the dog or part thereof may report such operations to the Kennel Club. I/We declare that where any alteration has been made to the natural conformation of the dog(s) the relevant permission to show has been granted by the Kennel Club. I/We further declare that I believe, to the best of my knowledge, that the dogs are not liable to disqualification under Kennel Club Show Regulations.

REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOGS FOR EXHIBITION F (Annex B)

1. These Regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Kennel Club Licensed event. Objections may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under these Show Regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rule A11.
 - a) A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these Regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained thereat.
 - b) Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these Regulations then he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under Rule A11.
2.
 - a) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the Show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present on the dog for any purpose at any time during the Show.
 - b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
3. No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed except:
 - (a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the Board.
 - (b) The removal of dew claws of any breed.
 - (c) Operations to prevent breeding provided that such operations are notified to the Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown.Nor must anything be done calculated in the opinion of the Board to deceive.
4. The Board without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any Show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
5. An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by an official of the Show or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate) to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
6. Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these Regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the Show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.

Dogs: Rob Harris (Nobozz)

I have had bulldogs for over 33 years and my affix is Nobozz Bulldogs. I have had some success in showing and breeding. In the ring have had over ten Champions in the UK as well as Champions overseas. My favourite was Nobozz Rock My World, which I campaigned in 2003. I am the only breeder in the UK to have had a Grand Champion made up in the USA, Nobozz Enter The Dragon. I have judged all over the world and have met some lovely people and seen some fantastic dogs in my life of bulldogs. I am looking forward to judging this prestige show and seeing some top quality dogs.

Bitches: David McHale

I have been breeding and showing Bulldogs for the last 45 years, my affix is KELLOE BULLDOGS. I originally started with my late partner Christian Bruton who sadly passed away in 2011 on the very day he should have judged Crufts.

Together Christain and I achieved many great things in Bulldogs. We are the breeders and owner of the top winning bulldog in the history of the breed (Champion Kelloe White Glove) who still owns this title today 25 years after winning an incredible 50 CC all under different judges, something I'm extremely proud of. We were also the owners of Champion Tyegarth Jacob of Kelloe, who achieved so much for bulldogs through the eighties. He was the winner of the utility group at Crufts and was Supreme Male Champion, winner of B.O.Y. I have bred many English Champions as well as Champions in most countries around the world. I have been judging at Championship level since 1985. I've had the honour of judging Crufts, my journey as a judge has taken me around the world. My passion for Bulldogs has never diminished from the day I started. I'm very much looking forward to judging the 125th Anniversary Show in 2019 being one of the oldest Bulldog clubs in the world.

Best in Show: Susan Rowe (Rockytop)

We bought our first Bulldog in 1972, a daughter of Ch Castizo Drummond. At her first breed club show she went Best Puppy in Show, and we were hooked. I awarded CCs for the first time at Darlington in 1989 and have been honoured to give tickets on a further 12 occasions in the UK, I have also judged in Europe several times. We also made up our first Champion in 1989. I am looking forward to judging BIS at Birmingham and Midland Counties Bulldog Club.
