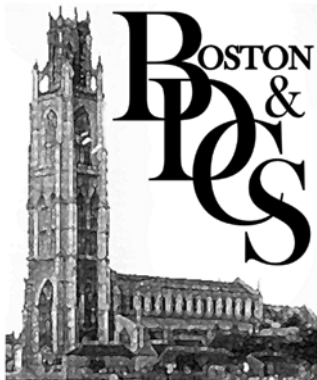

Jurisdiction and responsibilities: The Officers and Committee members of the society holding the licence are deemed responsible for organising and conducting the show safely and in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Kennel Club and agree to abide by and adopt any decision of the Board or any authority to whom the Board may delegate its powers subject to the conditions of Regulation F17. In so doing those appointed as officers and committee members accept that they are jointly and severally responsible for the organisation of the show and that this is a binding undertaking (vide Kennel Club General Show Regulations F4 and F5).

The Society will ensure to the best of its ability that the event is run to Covid Safe guidelines. It is your responsibility to ensure you comply with national and local restrictions including advice given about non-essential travel in and out of locally affected regions (which must not be ignored) – in the interests of the safety of all participants this may give rise to a short notice refusal of entry at the society's discretion. The Kennel Club will respect the society's exercise of its discretion. - ENTRIES CLOSE:** Postal entries close Friday, 19th November 2021 (*Postmark*). Entries can be made on-line up until midnight on Sunday, 28th November 2021 at www.fossedata.co.uk
- DOGS IN VEHICLES:** Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.
- ATTRACTING OF EXHIBITS:** The attracting of the attention of exhibits by any method from the ringside is prohibited. It is the duty of the Judge, Steward or Show Executive noticing such attraction to ask that it cease.
- DISCLAIMER:** The Committee of the Show can accept no responsibility for products advertised or sold by stand holders at the Show and remind exhibitors that grooming products on sale may not meet the requirements of the Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
- LITTER:** Litter bins will be provided. Please help to keep this venue clean and tidy by placing all paper, refuse etc. in the bins.
- STAKES CLASSES PRIZE MONEY:** The Treasurer's Office is open from 1.00 pm to 4.30 pm each day. **Prize Money must be claimed at the Show (UNCLAIMED PRIZE MONEY WILL NOT BE FORWARDED).**
- CHILDREN:** Will parents or any other persons in charge of CHILDREN at the Show, please note that they will be held responsible for the actions of the CHILDREN. Any damage caused by CHILDREN will be charged to the responsible adult.
- FOULING:** Any owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog is required to remove immediately any fouling caused by their dog(s) and/or any grooming waste at any Kennel Club licensed show within the licensed venue and within the environs of that event including car and caravan parks and approaches. Please Note: Exhibitors **MUST NOT** exercise their dogs, or go, beyond the precincts of the Show.
- GANGWAYS:** Exhibitors are requested to keep all gangways clear. No tables or cages around the ringside or in the gangways. Areas will be designated as Caging and Grooming areas (KC Rules).
- PENS:** No pens to be erected under any circumstances.
- JUDGING ORDER/JUDGE CHANGES:** The Judging Order, Judges changes etc. will be listed on our Facebook page and www.fossedata.co.uk. N.B. The Committee reserve the right to alter the judging order should it be considered necessary.
- CATALOGUES:** Pre-paid catalogues **MUST** be collected by 11.00 am.
- STAKES CLASSES:** Will not be judged before 1.00 pm.
- CAR PARKING: Free parking.** Car Park opens at 7.00 am. All vehicles including Motor Homes must be removed from all Car Parks one hour after the completion of judging each day. **Please Note: All vehicles are parked at owners risk.**
- DISABLED DRIVERS:** Disabled badge holders will be directed to the front of the car park where possible (limited spaces available). **With limited spaces, disabled parking cannot be reserved.**
- HEALTH & SAFETY:** Anyone entering the Arena from the car parks prior to the published show opening time of 7.30 am is not covered under the terms of the Society's insurance.
- PHOTOGRAPHY & VIDEO RIGHTS:** The Organisers would like to bring the regulation on photography and filming to the attention of exhibitors, trade stands, press and visitors. It is a condition of all those attending the event that no filming or other form of recording may be taken or made at the venue without express written permission of the organisers. The taking of photographs in the venue for sale or reward is strictly prohibited except with the written permission of the Organisers. Press accredited photographers are provided with permission to take photographs **ONLY** for use in newspapers, magazines and internet sites - this is for news purposes only. There is no objection to the general public taking photographs or video film of general views of the Show, provided that these are for private use only. Specific dogs may be photographed only with the approval of the exhibitor.
- No photography or filming is permitted in breed judging rings whilst judging is actually taking place. However, judges may allow it to happen at the end of classes or after the Challenge Certificate is awarded. Filming and flash photography is allowed from outside the rings at all times unless the operation of the camera is actually affecting exhibits. However, if a powerful flash unit is used or it is clear that exhibits are being affected, a ring steward or the judge is empowered to stop the person concerned. Cinematograph or television equipment may only be used at the Show if a permit has been issued by the Organisers.
- SPECTATOR DOGS:** Spectator Dogs will be accepted at this Show: £2.00 per dog (register at Secretary's table upon arrival).

BANK CHARGES: Cheques and Credit Card Payments sent to cover entry fees must be in order for **IMMEDIATE PAYMENT**. Any which are not, for whatever reason, will incur a surcharge of **£30.00**. Failure to cover the surcharge will result in the entry being returned.

ENTRY AMENDMENTS: No changes can be made to an entry after Sunday, 28th November 2021.

MEMBERSHIP: Single: £2.00 — Joint: £4.00 (per annum, 1st February - 31st January)

RETURN OF DOGS FOR COMPETITION: £15.00 per exhibit will be paid by Boston DCS to those dogs selected from the first three days to return on the final day to compete for Best in Show, Best Puppy in Show and Best Special Beginners in Show. The return money is to be collected from the Treasurer on the final day. Exhibitors returning for final competitions on the last day of the Show should obtain the appropriate passes and benching information from the Show Secretary.

SHOW REGULATIONS

1. **Opening of Show:** The Show will open at 7.30 am.
2. **Receipt of Dogs:** Dogs will be received at any time after 7.30 am but it is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that exhibits are available for judging when required.
3. **Judging Time: Judging will commence at: 9.30 am on Thursday/Friday; 9.00 am on Saturday/Sunday.**
4. **Removal of Exhibits and Close of Show:** Exhibits may be removed from the Show after their judging has been completed. Exhibits may not be removed any earlier unless by written order of the Veterinary Surgeon, Veterinary Practitioner or of the Show Management and then only in very exceptional and unforeseen circumstances which must be reported to the Kennel Club. The Show will close half an hour after ALL judging has been completed by which time dogs must be removed.
5. **Entry Fees:** Breeds with CCs on offer: First entry with each dog £28.00; Each subsequent entry with same dog £5.00. Breeds without CCs on offer/AVNSC/Imported Breed Register/AV Rare Breeds: First entry with each dog £15.00; Each subsequent entry with same dog £5.00. Stakes Classes/YKC Members' Handling Classes: £15.00 as a first entry; £5.00 as a subsequent entry. KC Breeders' Competition: £15.00 per team. Not for Competition: £10.00 per dog. Spectator Dogs will be accepted at this Show: £2.00 per dog (register at Secretary's table upon arrival). Catalogues: £5.00 per day pre-paid with entries; £6.00 on the day. Membership: Single £2.00; Joint £4.00. Car Parking: Free of charge. **Once entry fees have been received they are non-refundable.**
6. **Prize Money:** The following Prize Money is on offer and must be claimed at this Show: Birdbrook Rosettes Puppy Stakes: 1st £20.00; 2nd £15.00; 3rd £10.00; Reserve £5.00; VHC £3.00. Boston DCS Junior Stakes: 1st £20.00; 2nd £15.00; 3rd £10.00; Reserve £5.00; VHC £3.00. Fosse Data Systems Veteran Stakes: 1st £20.00; 2nd £10.00; 3rd £5.00; Reserve £4.00; VHC £3.00. Boston DCS Open Stakes: 1st £20.00; 2nd £15.00; 3rd £10.00; Reserve £5.00; VHC £3.00. Kennel Club Good Citizen Dog Scheme Stakes: 1st £50.00; 2nd £25.00; 3rd £15.00; Reserve £10.00; VHC £5.00. Kennel Club Breeders' Competition: 1st £20.00 Non ABS Prize Fund / £25.00 ABS Prize Fund. Kennel Club Special Beginners Groups: 1st £40.00; 2nd £30.00; 3rd £20.00; 4th £10.00.
7. **Refusal of Entries:** The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
8. **Puppies:** Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible for exhibition.
9. **Mating of Bitches:** The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
10. **Best Puppy in Show:** Where a Best Puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and has been declared Best Puppy in Breed, Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified Puppy or Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register Puppy. A puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. Where the Best of Breed, Best in Group or Best in Show is a puppy it should automatically be awarded Best Puppy in Breed, Best in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Similarly, if the Reserve Best of Breed, Reserve Best of Group or Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it should also automatically be Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Consequently, selection of Best Puppy in Breed, Best in Group and Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best of Breed and Best in Show respectively.
 - a. **Shows Judged on the Group System** (Definition; Shows judged on Group System - Refer to Regulation F(1)27.b)
 - 1) **Best Puppy in Breed:**

A Best Puppy must be declared in each breed from puppies entered in the breed classes.
A Best Puppy must be declared from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified class(es).
A Best Puppy must be declared from the Any Variety Imported Breed Register class(es).
 - 2) **Best Puppy in Group:** Best Puppy in Group and subsequent Puppy Group placings must be selected from:-
 - a) Those puppies declared Best Puppy in Breed.
 - b) The puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each Group.
 - c) The puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Imported Breed Register classes in each Group.
 - 3) **Best Puppy in Show:** Best Puppy in Show must be selected from the Best Puppy in Group winners.
11. **Best in Show:** The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has competed and has been declared Best of Breed, Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified or Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register.
 - a. **Shows Judged on the Group System**
 - 1) **Best of Breed:** Where a breed is separately classified a Best of Breed may be declared but only from those dogs which have received a first prize in a breed class at the show. Where separate classes are provided for each sex of a breed a Best of each Sex must be declared.
NOTE: The Best of Breed/Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified/ Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register award relevant to a Category 3 Breed will not be confirmed until the dog has passed an examination by the General and Group Championship Show Veterinary Surgeon.

- 2) **Best of Group:** Best of Group and subsequent Group placings must be selected from:-
- The Best of Breed winners in each group.
 - The dog declared Best from Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each Group.
 - The dog declared Best from Any Variety Imported Breed Register class or classes in each Group.
NOTE: The dog declared Best of Breed/Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified/ Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register from a breed designated by the Kennel Club as a Category 3 Breed is not eligible to compete in the Group competition unless it has passed an examination by the Show's Veterinary Surgeon. If the dog fails to pass the examination it is ineligible to compete in the relevant Group.
- 3) **Best in Show:** Best in Show must be selected from the Best of Group winners. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the remaining Group winners following the selection of Best in Show.
12. **Admission to Best in Show:** Exhibitors will not be admitted to Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.
13. **Harsh Handling:** Exhibitors must not pick up dogs by their tails and leads when lifting them nor handle a dog in a manner which causes its feet not to touch the ground when on the move. This is not acceptable. Exhibitors should note that such practice would constitute harsh handling and reports of such practice will be referred to the Committee under Kennel Club Show Regulation F11.
14. **Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition:** All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F (Annex B) - Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
15. **Overseas Exhibitors:** All dogs resident outside of the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
16. **Dogs in Vehicles on Hot Days:** Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events.
- When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
 - If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
 - The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
 - Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
 - When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
 - Keep the dog in the shade - take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
 - Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time.
- Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare. **WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.**
17. **Health & Welfare of Dogs:** Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of the Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any show licensed by the Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue or within the precincts of the show.
18. **Not for Competition:** Not for Competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club registered.
19. **Schedule Amendments:** No modifications will be made to this Schedule except by permission of the Board of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine Press wherever possible.
20. **Change of Judge:** Should any of the judges be prevented from fulfilling their engagements, the Show Committee reserves to itself the right of appointing other judges to fulfil their duties. Exhibitors are at liberty to withdraw from competition, but no entry fee can be refunded.
21. **Objections:** All objections must be made in accordance with the Kennel Club Regulations. Should any question arise not provided for by these Regulations or by the Kennel Club Rules, the decision of the Committee shall be final. The Committee of the Kennel Club is the Final Court of Appeal.
22. **Dog Fouling:** Any owner, competitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog is required to remove immediately any fouling caused by their dog(s), and/or any grooming waste, at any Kennel Club licensed show within the licensed venue and within the environs of that event including car and caravan parks and approaches. Any organisation holding a Kennel Club licensed event is required to provide an adequate number of receptacles for the disposal of such fouling and waste.

23. **Disclaimer:** The Committee of the Show can accept no responsibility for products advertised or sold by stand holders at the Show and remind exhibitors that grooming products on sale may not meet the requirements of the Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
 24. **Control of Dogs:** The owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog at Kennel Club licensed events must at all times ensure that the dog is kept under proper control whilst at the licensed venue, including its environs, car and caravan parks and approaches. This Regulation applies before (at any time during the set up period at the venue), during the event and afterwards (at any time during the breakdown of the event).
 25. **Disqualification:** A dog may be disqualified by the Board from any award, whether an objection has been lodged or not, if proved amongst other things to have been: a) registered or recorded as having been bred by the scheduled Judge, this shall not apply to a Judge appointed in an emergency; b) exhibited without payment of appropriate entry fees.
 26. **Identification:** Every exhibitor shall ensure that whilst the dog is being exhibited, its handler shall display the correct ring number.
 27. **Safety of dogs:** The Committee will not be responsible for the loss, detention of or damage to any dog, person or property, whether arising from accident, or any other cause whatever, or any act or omission of itself, its officers, agents, servants, or others or the damage done by the exhibitor to any person or property.
 28. **Responsibility:** The committee will not be in any way responsible for any claim for injury or compensation occasioned by or arising out of the holding of the Show, or by reason of the act or default of any person in attendance or present thereat. Boston Championship Dog Show do not accept any loss, damage, or theft of any dog, tables, boxes, cages, or personal effects at this Show.
 29. **Safety Officer:** A Safety Officer will be in attendance throughout the show. Exhibitors and spectators are reminded that just as Boston & District Canine Society has a responsibility to ensure the health and safety of all those attending their event, all those present have a duty of care for their own safety. They are therefore expected to take the greatest of care to avoid hazards which are inevitable and an integral element at a dog show. Those bringing portable items of equipment, such as folding chairs, trolleys, cages and grooming tables also have a duty of care to themselves, their equipment and their dogs. Exhibitors are also reminded they should wear appropriate footwear for the prevailing conditions on site, exhibitors show at their own risk if conditions are not ideal.
 30. **Abusive Behaviour:** The Society will not tolerate any kind of abusive behaviour to its Officers, Committee or Staff on its showground or car parks. Anyone found to be behaving in this manner will be reported to Security and asked to leave, a report will be sent to the Kennel Club.
 31. **Cancellation or Abandonment:** Entry fees will not be refunded in any circumstances where any act of God or any other unforeseen circumstances causes the cancellation of the show after entries have closed.
 32. **Electrical Equipment:** No use of electrical equipment or power sockets; anyone found using them without authorisation will be asked to leave the show and reported to the Kennel Club.
 33. **Health & Safety:** Anyone entering the Exhibition Hall from the car parks prior to the published show opening time of 7.30 am is not covered under the terms of the Society's insurance.
-

DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

In the following definitions a Challenge Certificate includes any Show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the Rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club. Wins at Championship Shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows.

In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' Specials each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Society. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the date of closing of postal entries shall be counted when entering for any class i.e. **Friday, 12th November 2021**.

Wins in Variety classes do not count for entry in Breed classes but when entering in Variety classes, wins in both Breed and Variety classes must be counted. A First Prize does not include a Special Prize of whatever value.

If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:

1) *Withdrawal*

The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulation F.(1).19.

2) *Transfer*

(a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its breed, colour, sex, weight or height the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and, in the event of

there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy and Puppy excepted, to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex weight or height;

- (b) If an exhibit is entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy class, Puppy class or Junior class, which is over age but under twelve calendar months of age, eighteen calendar months of age or twenty four calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy class, Junior class or Yearling class respectively for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling class to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
- (c) For any reason other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
- (d) If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

MINOR PUPPY For dogs of six and not exceeding nine calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

PUPPY For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

JUNIOR For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

YEARLING For dogs of twelve and not exceeding twenty four calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

GRADUATE For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or four or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Graduate, Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

POST GRADUATE For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or five or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

LIMIT For dogs which have not become show Champions under Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club, or won 3 or more CC/CACIB/CAC/Green Stars or won 7 or more First Prizes in all at Championship Shows in Limit or Open Classes, confined to the breed, whether restricted or not, at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

OPEN For all dogs of the breeds for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the Show.

GOOD CITIZEN DOG SCHEME CLASS For dogs that have achieved their GCDS Bronze Award Certificate or above.

VETERAN For dogs of not less than seven years of age on the first day of the Show.

SPECIAL BEGINNERS For owner, handler or exhibit not having won a Challenge Certificate or Reserve Challenge Certificate, or for those breeds not allocated Championship Status, Best of Sex or Reserve Best of Sex at a Championship Show.

SPECIAL OPEN RACING/LURE COURSING For Kennel Club registered Greyhounds which must also be registered with the N.G.R.C. or the N.C.C.

ANY VARIETY NOT SEPARATELY CLASSIFIED For breeds of dog for which no separate breed classes are scheduled. These classes are not open to breeds which are listed on the Imported Breed Register.

ANY VARIETY A Variety Class is one in which more than one breed or variety of a breed with a breed standard can compete.

IMPORTED BREED REGISTER For breeds confined to the Imported Breeds Register and only when an Interim Breed Standard has been published by The Kennel Club. Such breeds may be exhibited in this class with the Best Imported Register / Best Imported Register Puppy being eligible for Best in Group / Best Puppy in Group or Best in Show / Best Puppy in Show as relevant. Such breeds may be entered into Imported Breed Register classes and/or Any Variety or Stakes classes, with the exception of AVNSC classes, for which they are not eligible.

RARE BREEDS Confined to those breeds not granted Challenge Certificates in the current year, with the exception of those breeds whose registration is confined to the Imported Breed Register.

BIRDBROOK ROSETTES PUPPY STAKES For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

FOSSE DATA SYSTEMS VETERAN STAKES For dogs of not less than seven years of age on the first day of the Show.

BOSTON DCS JUNIOR STAKES For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

BOSTON DCS OPEN STAKES For all dogs of the breeds for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the Show.

KENNEL CLUB GOOD CITIZEN DOG SCHEME STAKES For dogs that have achieved their GCDS Bronze Award Certificate or above.

KENNEL CLUB BREEDERS' COMPETITION Each team will consist of a minimum of three and maximum of four dogs of one breed, all bred by the same breeder or breeding partnership. The breeder enters the class and then arranges which dogs are exhibited on the day of the show (from those dogs duly entered for exhibition in another class at this show). Please clearly state the name and affix of the registered breeder(s). Entries will not be taken on the day of the show. Teams will be awarded points/prize money in the KC Breeders' Competition as follows: Points 1st; 30; 2nd 15; 3rd 10; 4th 5. Prize Money 1st Non ABS Prize Fund £20; ABS Prize Fund £25. Please note that Assured Breeders will be credited with a higher prize value. These points will be recorded in the Kennel Club Breeders Competition record book through the year. The minimum qualification for the Crufts final will be 50 points, with a maximum of 40 finalists including the winning teams from the European and World Dog Shows' breeders competition. Our Dogs will collate the points and publish a leader board through the year. **Please Note: Dogs which take part in the Breeders' Competition, but are not entered in the show, are required to have a completed entry form. Owners of these dogs must attend the Secretary's office to complete the entry form.**

YKC MEMBERS' STAKES Only dogs of six (6) calendar months of age and over on the day of competition are eligible for entry into a YKC qualifying stakes class. Dogs must be on the Kennel Club Breed register to compete in a YKC stakes competition. The YKC method for Crufts qualification is a points based system as follows: 1st Place = 30 points; 2nd Place = 15 points; 3rd Place = 10 points. If a member and dog combination accumulate 30 points or more, they will qualify for Crufts. Points will be allocated for the Dog and Handler pairing. All points are reset to 0 on 1st February each year. All pedigree dogs are eligible to take part provided the dog is registered on the Kennel Club Breed Register. The dog must be registered; a. Solely or jointly in the member's name or b. In the name of a close member of the family (i.e a group of people related by blood or marriage) and under these circumstances the dog must be resident at the YKC member's address. No substitute handlers are permitted - the dog must be handled by the registered YKC member. Members are not permitted to allow another individual to show their dog at the qualifier on their behalf if they are not able to attend the class, unless agreed by the YKC Office prior to the show. Members must be aged 6 -24 years (members 6 years and up to, but not including 25th birthday). Please note that membership of the YKC terminates on a members 25th birthday. Therefore if a member is aged 25 years or over by the first day of Crufts they will be unable to compete in any YKC class. Please keep this in mind when entering qualifiers throughout the competing year. In order to enter any YKC competition, you must be a fully paid up member at the time of entry and competition. If you enter a Crufts qualifier and you have not previously paid your membership fee then any award will be forfeited. Therefore it is important to renew and maintain YKC membership as current if you wish to participate in YKC competitions. Before competing, please view a full list of the YKC competition rules at: www.ykc.org.uk/ and follow the compete tab.

YKC MEMBERS' HANDLING CLASSES Only dogs of six (6) calendar months of age and over on the day of competition are eligible for entry into an YKC qualifying class. Classes for handling are decided by the handler's age. The classes are divided into three age groups: 6-11 years (6 years and up to, but not including 12th birthday); 12-17 years (12 years and up to, but not including 18th birthday); 18-24 years (18 years and up to, but not including 25th birthday). Please enter the class age category you will be on the day of the qualifier. If you should move into the next age range after you have already qualified, the YKC will invite you into the correct age group at Crufts. The method for Crufts qualification is a points based system as follows: 1st Place = 30 points; 2nd Place = 15 points; 3rd Place = 10 points. Members will receive points per group (i.e. if they handle a bloodhound, they will get points towards the Hound group). If a member gets 30 points in any one group during the year, they will qualify to enter a dog from that group in the following year's YKC Handling Crufts classes. If a member gains 30 or more points in multiple groups, they may only compete with one dog at Crufts, but they will have the option to choose from any of the groups they have 30 or more points in. The YKC may have to drastically alter how members qualify for Crufts 2023. This may be because fewer shows were able to hold YKC qualifiers this year, or possibly that we are required to restrict entry numbers to Crufts 2023 on government advice. More up to date qualification information will be released on the YKC website closer to the time. The YKC will endeavour to keep the qualification process as close to the above as possible. YKC handling classes may be the first and only entry for a dog at this show. If, at this show, a dog is entered only into a YKC Handling class (i.e. that dog is not entered in a breed class or YKC Stakes class), that dog must be registered on either the relevant Kennel Club breed register or the Kennel Club activity register. If a dog is entered into YKC handling and any other class (i.e. a breed class or YKC Stakes class), that dog must be on the relevant Kennel Club breed register.

ADVISORY NOTICE

NOT FOR COMPETITION Societies may at their discretion, accept Not for Competition entries. Societies may accept such entries from breeds of dog not included within the title of the Society and at Shows held over more than one day, such entries may be accepted on any day from any breed.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

EXHIBITOR PASSES - FOR ON-LINE ENTRIES ONLY: You will not receive your Exhibitors Pass through the post because they will be delivered to you through your on-line account. You will be informed by an e-mail when your passes are ready, which will be approximately two weeks before the show.

The e-mail will include details on how to print your Exhibitors Pass and any other Show Information. Your ring number(s) will be included as part of your pass and you must print this out and take it with you to the show for use in the ring.

Exhibitors making postal entries will receive their Exhibitors Passes (including ring numbers) by Post in the usual way.
