Please note the points below:

1. Tick the box near your name and address on the front of the entry form if you do NOT want your ADDRESS to appear in the catalogue. Your name will still be printed above your dog records as normal.
2. Your address is still needed for sending out your exhibitor pass so you must still enter your address in the normal way.

WELFARE OF DOGS

Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

Right to Refuse Entries: Exhibitors/Competitors are reminded that show societies have the right under Kennel Club Regulation to refuse any entry.

• EXHIBITOR PASSES •

Exhibitors will receive a free pass for each dog entered. Partners (i.e. two or more owners) entering one dog only will receive one additional free helper's pass. An exhibitor entering a single dog which is owned by only one person is now entitled to TWO free passes.

**If acknowledgement of receipt of entries is required,
a stamped, addressed postcard must be enclosed with entries.**

To avoid delay, do not include payments other than those for Crufts entries.

Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.
