About our Group and BIS Judges

John Purnell (Yikasown) — Working Group Judge

I award CCs in Miniature Pinschers, Dobermanns, Siberian Huskys and Rottweilers. I have had more than 90 BIS appointments in the UK, Ireland and Malta and my judging has taken me to Siberia, Moscow, Poland and Latvia.

Carol Moore (Gadhelic) — Gundog Group Judge

My foundation Gordon Setter I made into a Show Champion and achieved the same success with two of her homebred descendants. I have also won group placings and RCCs with my Field Spaniels. I am Chairman of the Setter & Pointer Club and was on the committee of Wrexham & District Kennel Society as Treasurer from 1990-2008. I am a committee member of Goyt Valley Gundog Society. I have judged since 1980 covering a wide geographical area and judging most of the breed within the Gundog group as well as the Group and BIS at Open Show level.

Clare Boggia (Boughton) — Hound Group Judge

I grew up with Whippets and French Bulldogs, my first show dog was a Greyhound, from Dagmar Kenis Pordham's famous Solstrand kennel. I have been lucky enough to have owned or bred 27 UK Champion Greyhounds. I am currently Chairman of the Greyhound Club and Secretary of Ashford Faversham & DCS. I award CCs in Greyhounds, Whippets, French Bulldogs and Salukis. I am looking forward to judging for Reading Premier Open Show.

Leila Tarabad (Khatibi) — Toy Group Judge

I have been showing dogs, mainly Cavaliers but I have also had a King Charles Spaniel, Japanese Chin, Lhasa Apso and Tibetan Terrier. I judged for the first time in 1999 as a teenager and have never looked back! I award CCs in CKCS, Papillons, Chinese Crested and Bichons, am approved to award CCs in six further Toy breeds in 2020 and appear on B and C lists for most of the other Toy breeds. I am delighted to be judging the Toy group at Reading this year and really look forward to my day.

Glenn Davies (Waterley) — Utility Group Judge

I have lived with pedigree dogs for most of my life, but the Tibetan Terrier was my life choice. I have owned and exhibited for 30+ years and along with Mark James, have owned and bred more than 20 champions. I started judging them officially in 1991 and was passed to award CCs in 2003. I now award CCs in 6 Utility breeds and have recently been passed to judge the Utility Group. I follow the progress of many of the breeds in this group and always enjoy my opportunities and good fortune to judge them.

Neil Straw (Shaolin) — Terrier Group Judge

Been around dogs all my life. Success with Scottish Terriers and recently a Border Terrier. Also involved with breeds in the Hound, Gundog & Utility Groups. I award CCs in 7 Terrier breeds, am approved for 2 more in 2020 as well as the Terrier Group at Championship show level. I am Chairperson of the Scottish Terrier Breed Council and in my 31st year as a breed club Secretary. I am delighted to have been invited to judge at Reading again and look forward to the day with interest.

Debbie Stansbury (Woodbriar) — Pastoral Group Judge

Debbie bought her first Dobermann in 1980 and started showing. A Groenendael joined the pack in 1993 followed by an Afghan in 1999. Her first judging appointment was in 1985 and now awards CCs in 6 Working breeds, the Group and 8 Pastoral breeds. With her husband she has Stud Book entries in BSD, Boxers and Dobermanns including a Working Group Winner. She has been a founder member of several clubs and currently she is Vice President & Secretary of Plymouth & District CS and Vice President & Treasurer of Duchy CS. She is also a KC Accredited Trainer.

Stephen Bardwell — Best in Show Judge

I started showing Yorkshire Terriers in the 1970s and have bred, owned and shown Champion Yorkies, Griffons and Schnauzers. To a lesser degree I have also bred and shown Airedale, Norwich and Lakeland Terriers and am currently "owned" by two Curly Coated Retrievers. I am passed to award CCs in all Toy breeds and the Toy Group (since 1998). I am also passed to award CCs in three Utility breeds and one in the Gundog Group. I am also a KC Accredited Trainer for Confirmation and Movement.

• RULES & REGULATIONS •

1. The Show will open at 9.00 am.
2. Dogs will be received at any time but it is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that exhibits are available for judging when required.
3. Judging will commence at 10.00 am.
4. Exhibits may be removed from the Show after their judging has been completed. The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed.
5. Entry Fees: First entry per dog £6.00; each subsequent class with same dog £2.00. **Junior Handling:** £2.00 per class. **Not for Competition:** £1.00 per dog (Full details of the dog(s) **MUST** be given on the entry form and dog(s) **MUST** be at least 6 months of age of the day of the show). **Catalogues:** £3.00 pre-paid **ONLY** (to be ordered with entry). **Membership (per annum):** Single £2.00; Joint £2.50.
6. Prize Money is on offer for 1st - VHC in all Stakes Classes as follows: 1st £25.00; 2nd £20.00; 3rd £12.00; Reserve £10.00; VHC £8.00.
7. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
8. Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible for exhibition.
9. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
10. **Best Puppy in Show:** Where a Best Puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and has been declared Best Puppy in Breed, Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified Puppy or Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register Puppy. A puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. Where the Best of Breed, Best in Group or Best in Show is a puppy it should automatically be awarded Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Where the Reserve Best of Breed, Reserve Best of Group or Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it should also automatically be Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Consequently, selection of Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best of Breed, Best in Group and Best in Show respectively.
Best Puppy in Group and subsequent Group placings must be selected from:
 - a) Those puppies declared Best Puppy in Breed.
 - b) The puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each group.
 - c) The puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Imported Breed Register classes in each group.Best Puppy in Show must be selected from the Best Puppy in Group winners.
11. **Best in Show:** The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has competed and has been declared Best of Breed, Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified or Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register.
 - a. Shows Judged on the Group System: (Definition: Shows judged on the Group System includes classes for breeds within more than one group, as defined in Kennel Club Regulation B(A); and require a judge to declare a best of each group after which the exhibits so declared will compete for the award of Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show).
 - 1) Best of Breed: Where a breed is separately classified a Best of Breed may be declared but only from those dogs which have received a first prize in a breed class at the show. Where separate classes are provided for each sex of a breed a Best of each Sex must be declared.
 - 2) Best of Group: Best of group and subsequent placings must be selected from:-
 - a) The Best of Breed winners in each group.
 - b) The Best dog from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each group.
 - c) The Best dog from Any Variety Imported Breed Register classes in each group.
 - 3) Best in Show: Best in Show must be selected from the Best of Group winners. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the remaining Group winners following the selection for Best in Show.
12. Exhibits will not be admitted to Group or Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.
13. Exhibitors must not pick up dogs by their tails and leads when lifting them nor handle a dog in a manner which causes its feet not to touch the ground when on the move. This is not acceptable. Exhibitors should note that such practice would constitute harsh handling and reports of such practice will be referred to the Committee under Kennel Club Show Regulation F I I.
14. All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F (Annex B) - Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
15. All dogs resident outside of the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
16. **Dogs in Vehicles on Hot Days.** Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events.

- When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
- If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
- The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
- Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
- When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
- Keep the dog in the shade - take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
- Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time.

Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare. **WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.**

17. Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under the Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any show licensed by the Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue or within the precincts of the show.
18. Not for Competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club registered.
19. No modifications will be made to this Schedule except by permission of the Board of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine Press wherever possible.
20. Should any question arise not provided for in these regulations the decision of the Committee shall be final subject only to appeal to the Kennel Club.
21. Should any judge be prevented from fulfilling his or her engagement, the Committee reserve the right to appoint another judge or judges in their place. Exhibitors may withdraw from competition but no entry fees can be returned.
22. The owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog at Kennel Club licensed events must at all times ensure that the dog is kept under proper control whilst at the licensed venue, including its environs, car and caravan parks and approaches. This Regulation applies before (at any time during the set up period at the venue), during the event and afterwards (at any time during the breakdown of the event).
23. The Committee will be empowered to exclude or remove any dog which is not in a fit state for exhibition either from illness, disease, vice, natural or other causes, and if such exclusion takes place either before or after judging the entry fee will be forfeited.
24. The Committee will be most anxious for the care and safety of all dogs entered for exhibition and for any property entrusted to it, but it must be clearly understood by exhibitors and any other persons that the Committee will not be responsible for the entire or partial loss, or detention of, or damage to any dog or person for any cause whatsoever, nor for act or omission of themselves, their officers, agents and others, and it is on this understanding only that entries are received.
25. No animal other than an exhibit duly entered at the Show will be allowed within the precincts of the Show during its continuance.
26. The Committee of the Show can accept no responsibility for products advertised or sold by standholders at the Show and remind exhibitors that grooming products on sale may not meet the requirements of the Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition (KCSR(F)).
27. A dog may be disqualified by the Board from any award, whether an objection has been lodged or not, if proved amongst other things to have been: a) registered or recorded as having been bred by the scheduled Judge, this shall not apply to a Judge appointed in an emergency; b) exhibited without payment of appropriate entry fees.
28. Every exhibitor shall ensure that whilst the dog is being exhibited, its handler shall display the correct ring number.
29. Electrical equipment should not be brought to shows unless absolutely necessary. In rare instances where it might be required, it should be PAT tested and permission sought from the secretary of the show before it is used.

• DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES •

In the following definitions, a Challenge Certificate includes any Show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the Rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club. Wins at Championship Shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows. In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' Specials each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Society.

In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the date of closing of postal entries shall be counted when entering for any class i.e. **Monday, 27th April 2020.**

Wins in Variety classes do not count for entry in Breed classes but when entering in Variety classes, wins in both Breed and Variety classes must be counted. A first prize does not include a Special Prize of whatever value.

If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:-

(1) *Withdrawal*

The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulation F.(1).19.

(2) *Transfer*

- a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its breed, colour, sex, weight or height the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and, in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy and Puppy excepted to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
- b) If an exhibit is entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy class, Puppy class or Junior class, which is over age but under twelve calendar months of age, eighteen calendar months of age or twenty four calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy class, Junior class or Yearling class respectively for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling class to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
- c) For any reason other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
- d) If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

PUPPY For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

JUNIOR For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

YEARLING For dogs of twelve and not exceeding twenty four calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

NOVICE For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or three or more First Prizes at Open and Championship Shows (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special puppy classes excepted, whether restricted or not).

POST GRADUATE For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or five or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

LIMIT For dogs which have not become show Champions under the Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club, or won 3 or more CC/CACIB/CAC/Green Stars or won 7 or more First Prizes in all at Championship Shows in Limit or Open Classes confined to the Breed, whether restricted or not at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

OPEN For all dogs of the breeds for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the Show.

VETERAN For dogs of seven years and over on the first day of the Show.

VINTAGE For dogs of ten years and over on the first day of the Show.

CHAMPION For dogs which have been confirmed a Champion or Show Champion under Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club.

SPECIAL BEGINNERS For owner, handler or exhibit not having won a Challenge Certificate.

ANY VARIETY NOT SEPARATELY CLASSIFIED For breeds of dog for which no separate breed classes are scheduled.

IMPORTED BREED REGISTER For breeds confined to the Imported Breeds Register and only when an Interim Breed Standard has been published by the Kennel Club. Such breeds may be exhibited in this class only, with the winning dog being eligible for Best in Group / Best Puppy in Group or Best in Show / Best Puppy in Show as relevant.

ADVISORY NOTICE

NOT FOR COMPETITION Societies may at their discretion, accept Not for Competition entries. Societies may accept such entries from breeds of dog not included within the title of the Society and at Shows held over more than one day, such entries may be accepted on any day from any breed.

• DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOWGROUND •

The Newbury Showground is at the junction of the M4 and the A34
about 2 miles north of Newbury

FROM THE EAST OR WEST you come off the M4 at Junction 13 and take the A34 north, signposted to the Newbury Showground and Oxford.

The slip road for the Showground is **just 300 yards** from the junction.

FROM THE SOUTH you go underneath the motorway at Junction 13 and leave the A34 by the slip road as above.

FROM THE NORTH take the East Ilsey turn off the A34 if signposted — the junction after the one for Chilton. Follow the sign for Compton, then Hampstead Norrey, then Hermitage and Newbury. Turn right into Priors Court Road signposted Chieveley just after you leave Hermitage. If you miss the turning to East Ilsey go down to Junction 13, passing the Showground on your left, come right around the roundabout underneath the junction and take the slip road as above.
